APPLICATION REOUIREMENTS

Ist Prize \$2,500. 2nd Prize \$1,500. 3rd Prize \$1,000.

The Association for Women in Architecture Foundation, Inc. offers cash awards to women students who by April 21, 2005, have completed at least one full year (18 units minimum) of Architecture; Civil, Structural, Mechanical, or Electrical Engineering as related to Architecture; Landscape Architecture; Urban and Land Planning; Interior Design; Architectural Rendering and Illustration; or Environmental Design, and leading to a Degree. Selection will be based on Grades, Personal Statement, Financial Need, Recommendations, and on the quality and organization of materials submitted. Applicants must be RESIDENTS OF CALIFORNIA OR ATTENDING A CALIFORNIA SCHOOL, AND MUST BE ENROLLED UNDER ONE OF THE ABOVE MAJORS FOR THE NEXT 2005 SCHOOL TERM.

Any woman interested in applying may reproduce her school's Application Forms, or request one from the Association for Women in Architecture Foundation (address and telephone number shown below), or from the AWAF website: www.awa-la.org.

The AWAF Scholarship Committee will review the applications. A maximum of ten (10) finalists will be invited for personal interviews in Los Angeles on Sunday, May 01, 2005 where they will present and discuss samples of their school projects. This interview is MANDATORY! Applicants must provide their own transportation to the interview.

The winners will be notified in May. Certificates will be presented to the winners at an AWAF Honors Dinner in October. Checks will be issued after the Scholarship Committee has verified confirmation of enrollment for the next term.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

TO BE CONSIDERED, APPLICANTS MUST MAIL ALL OF THE FOLLOWING 6 DOCUMENTS (OR ITEMS) TO AWAF BEFORE THE DEADLINE DATE: 1:00 PM, THURSDAY, APRIL 21, 2005.

- ITEM #1. The AWAF completed "APPLICATION FORM" (enclosed).
- ITEM #2. "TWO (2) LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION" (from two instructors, <u>not</u> employers, in your field of study).
- ITEM #3. "OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS" of all your college and/or university grades.
- ITEM #4. The AWAF completed "FINANCIAL STATEMENT" (enclosed).
- ITEM #5. A "WRITTEN PERSONAL STATEMENT" (One side of one (I) 8-1/2" x 11" page maximum). Give your reasons for studying your chosen field, your career objectives, and what you plan to be doing in 5 or 10 years.
- ITEM #6. A "SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED (9-1/2" x 4") ENVELOPE".

All above-mentioned Documents (Items), except Official Transcripts, must be mailed together in a Packet addressed to "AWAF Scholarship". Transcripts mailed directly by your school must arrive by the deadline noted below. All complete Application Packages (including separately mailed transcripts) must be received at the address below by 1:00 PM Thursday, April 21, 2005
